

## BDO Remit talks about saving for the future

To enlighten its listeners, especially OFWs and their families, about the value of saving for the future, BDO Senior Manager and Unit Head of Financial Literacy and Pre-Departure Orientation Seminar (PDOS) Rose Tendencia was recently invited to talk about financial literacy and business in Sonshine Radio Station's "Bayaning Manggagawa, Bayaning OFW". Tendencia talked about the importance of saving. "OFWs sometimes go back to the Philippines without any savings," she said. "BDO wants to guide our *kababayans* abroad and their families here in the Philippines in managing their finances properly."

BDO, in partnership with Philippine Overseas Employment Administration, is conducting Financial Literacy Lectures as part of Pre-Employment Orientation Seminar for aspiring OFWs. BDO also partnered with several PDOS providers so they can conduct the same lectures during the mandatory seminars for OFWs already bound for abroad. During the lectures, the OFWs are encouraged to save a portion of their income for their future. They are also reminded that BDO provides tools that will help them achieve their dreams and aspirations. "We, from BDO, can advise OFWs on how they can take care of their money," Tendencia said. "They can open two BDO Kabayan Saving Accounts—one for their personal savings, the other one for the monthly allowance of their families in the Philippines. So when the time comes that they already want to go home, they have enough savings they can use for investments," she added.
